INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT

A. PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:-

Sports Activities:

Sports teach students to be emotionally strong. Most of the students often have to deal with some of the other emotional issues in their life, either at home or in school. The skill they develop through sports helps them to accept all defeats as well as wins. Hence, students who love games and sports are in a much better position to deal with tough situations.

Ample opportunities were provided to our students to play and prove their mettle in view sports and games at Vidyalaya level, regional and National level competitions.

Prize in 2 events (5 & 6 classes) Throw ball and Shot-put, 3rd prize in Running 100mts. (9 & 10 and 5 & 6 classes category) at Inter school competition conducted by Delhi Public School, Nadargul, and Hyderabad on 27th August 2022.


